That's why, once a month, we open the downstairs to provide larger items like strollers, highchairs, pack n' plays, baby baths, baby beds, changing tables, playmats, exercisers, and more to our member families. We also provide bags of toys and books once a month, as well as open our maternity closet for pregnant mothers.


books to our families, along with information on programming for toddlers at Columbus Metropolitan Library's local branches.

COMMUNITY BABY SHOWER

On Saturday June 12, 2021, at Glenwood Community Center, Celebrate One and Little Bottoms hosted a Community Baby Shower. Families who were expecting a new baby, or had children less than 1 year old, drove through the parking lot at Glenwood to receive gifts and information from numerous community resources. These resources included: Little Bottoms, Celebrate One, the YMCA, Hilltop.org, Franklinton.org, Lower Lights, Moderna Health Care, CareSource, Columbus Metropolitan Library, etc.

Little Bottoms volunteers packed 100 new Diaper Bags, 15 Dad Back Packs, and 100 Gifts Bags for families with new babies. The bags included a Baby Sleep Book, Pacifiers, Changing Pads, Sippy Cups, Wipes, Lotion, Shampoo, and Hand Sanitizer.

Each car received popcorn, cookies, and flavored ice

cones, and picked a large item ticket to receive gifts like Pack'n'Plays, highchairs, strollers, baby swings, toys, a wagon full of goodies, etc.

Little Bottoms packed and supplied 4,000 diapers, as well as 100 gift bags that included a new Bib and Pacifier Clip, and recruited 31 volunteers to help at the event.







SERVING NEW AMERICANS

A member of our church is friends with a family who recently immigrated to the US through the Mexican border. After being released from a detention center in Texas, the family was able to get tickets to Columbus, where they have moved into a basement of a friend. They had nothing but a mattress, and reached out



for help. Little Bottoms supported this family and their two-year-old child, providing clothing, supplies, toys, a winter coat, and even bus passes to ensure their family could access necessary resources while awaiting their appointment with ICE.
